FOREWORD

This document is the 2016 University College Roosevelt (UCR) research report. University College Roosevelt is a liberal arts and sciences undergraduate college of Utrecht University dedicated to providing the best possible teaching and learning environment for its students. In addition to its core aim as a teaching college, UCR is involved in both regular and undergraduate research. It is our conviction that within a university setting, there can be no sustained teaching excellence without research. This research report provides an overview of the output of the research activities in the course of 2016. In real terms, it pertains to more than half of the standing faculty. It is the fourth consecutive annual UCR research report to be published and the second by the current Director of Research. This foreword briefly synthesizes some of the more visible output that is contained in this report.

Undergraduate research (UR) is a centrally important activity at UCR. For a teaching college, it is also the ideal way to support faculty whose main work is focused on teaching and service. Working in teams with talented UR students on contemporary societal research projects gives energy and dynamism to students and faculty alike. The undergraduate research community is funded through the student undergraduate research fund (SURF), which helps students financially with either internships (i.e. for data collection trips) or when presenting their work at either a senior international research conferences or an undergraduate research conferences. €25,000 per calendar year is set aside for this. In 2016, UCR funded 43 students (almost double that of 2015, when 22 were funded) to conduct undergraduate research. Their projects varied widely. Some examples include conference presentations at senior international conferences in Italy and the UK; research trips to gather data in places like Brazil, Romania and Luxembourg. Closer to home, much medical undergraduate research was conducted while on summer internship projects in the hospitals of Utrecht/Nieuwegein (supervised by Prof. Dr. G. Rijkers & Dr. F. v Overveld). Students also again took part in the excavations at Waterloo (supervised by V. Haverkate & Dr. H. Hochscheid). Furthermore, students continued to work on the TERRA project, which involved presenting both abroad and in the community (supervised by Dr. E. Park & Dr. M. Sklad). One student (from the SCI department) had her abstract accepted by the national student Research Conference (SRC) organized by Science Works and her project was presented at the conference in Nijmegen in November 2016. [*In 2017, UCR will host the SCR conference*].

Undergraduate research was also funded at UCR in 2016 through the Utrecht University PUUR project (the program for upgrading undergraduate research) which UCR shares with her sister college UCU. It is a two-year program (2015-2016). Four PUUR UR research seminars are planned in this two-year period. Two of these seminars took place in 2016. The first was on poetics and art entitled 'Images of the end: Critical approaches to understanding disaster in art' was run in the spring semester by Dr. C. Weidner (ACC dept.) in cooperation with the Center for Humanities at Utrecht University. The second was on 'embodied cognition and reading' entitled 'cultural texts, brains and bodies' and was run in the fall semester by Prof. dr. M. Burke (ACC dept.). This culminated with a presentation of six

joint research projects at the University of Utrecht for faculty and students (graduate & undergraduate). In December 2016, four of the student abstracts were accepted at both a student research conference to be held in St. Petersburg in April 2017 and at a senior scholars conference (on literary semantics) to be held in the UK. One paper was also accepted for a prestigious academic conference on 'Cognitive Humanities' in New York (Stony Brook).

Also within the PUUR framework, this year a student (Kyra Tejero) completed an internship project on the *Corpus Vasorum Antiquorum* of the Utrecht University Museum (under the supervision of Dr. F. van den Eijnde (UU) and Dr. H. Hochscheid (UCR)). The student studied and wrote entries for several ancient Greek vases in the forthcoming volume CVA Utrecht I. More joint student-supervisor publications will emerge from this project in the coming years.

In addition to the SURF and PUUR programs, UCR is also active in UR within the Erasmus+ BLASTER grant framework (the "best of liberal arts and sciences expanded and reinforced"): Undergraduate Research is one of the three core pillars within that project. UCR sent a group of students from the 'embodied cognition and reading' undergraduate research seminar to present their work at a BLASTER event in Lüneburg in Germany.

This year, the 10th edition of the UCR undergraduate research journal *Ad Astra* was published and contained six original articles from across the disciplines. Also, the medical students launched their own inter-college national undergraduate research journal and published the first issue.

In addition to the undergraduate research at UCR described above, several UCR faculty members have again been research active in 2016. Academic research conducted by UCR faculty in 2016 has been published in a variety of leading journals across the disciplines, including *The Scientific Study of Literature*, *PLoS One*, *Frontiers in Psychology*, *Journal of Sustainable Development and Contemporary Educational Psychology*. Books have also been written and (co-)edited by UCR faculty (see appendix for a selection of covers). Topics have varied from literature to linguistics to human rights and the academic publishing houses involved have included Cambridge University Press, John Benjamins and Bloomsbury.

A significant number of research talks were delivered by UCR faculty at international and national academic conferences. These included a number of keynote addresses by senior faculty/full professors. Many UCR faculty currently serve on editorial boards of journals and academic organizations, review article manuscripts, edit the work of their peers, sit as panel members of promotions, and evaluate sister departments in national audits. The full professors within the UCR faculty are also supervising several PhD candidates, some of whom defended their PhDs at Utrecht University in the course of 2016. UCR full professors have also played important roles as external examiners on PhD committees at other universities, both nationally and internationally.

This year, an interdisciplinary group of UCR academics interested in the cross-disciplinary field of 'culture, communication and cognition' (Dr. G. Andringa, Prof. dr. M. Burke, Dr. G. Dijkershuis & Dr. H. Hochscheid) launched a special series for *Frontiers in Psychology*, a leading open access academic journal, where they select, manage, edit and

publish cutting edge papers on the topic of 'The Impact of Psychology and Neuroscience on Theories of Identification and Liking in the Humanities', thus facilitating publishing opportunities for academic colleagues from across the world (<http://journal.frontiersin.org/researchtopic/4773/the-impact-of-psychology-and-neuroscience-on-theories-of-identification-and-liking-in-the-humanities>).

Back in Middelburg, KAIROS, the UCR humanities and social sciences research center, was also active again in 2016, organizing guest lectures and small symposia to stimulate research interest, collaboration and output among faculty and students. In addition to core research supported by KAIROS, outreach to the local community (societal impact) remains paramount to UCR's research aspirations. Successful ongoing local research projects include the "practical markers for Alzheimer's disease" project and the related "effects of light therapy in people with dementia" project run by Dr. G. Andringa.

UCR has also actively continued to support the initiatives started in 2015 to reinforce Zeeland's knowledge infrastructure, emphasizing the crucial importance of strengthening higher education and research in the Province. Some of the initiatives are the Roosevelt Centre for Excellence in Education and the Platform on Delta Research. Another way in which UCR contributes to general academic research in Zeeland is via its support to PhD students in general. UCR professors supervise PhDs. Some of these candidates are based in Middelburg, whilst others live elsewhere. To contribute to the general success of the PhD students in Middelburg, UCR opened a PhD community in the Burg in 2015, which is still active.

In 2016, faculty research activities at UCR were stimulated by financial support from the research fund, which is primarily generated by revenues from the PhD defences at Utrecht University of candidates supervised by UCR's full professors. The Director of Research currently manages three research budgets: two UR and one faculty research (including PhD research). A total of €25.000 was available for faculty research, from which €5,000 was earmarked for (PhD) graduate funding. Faculty could also have a conference presentation visit directly funded from their own departmental budget (depending on the budget division strategy). UR projects (primarily internships and conference talks) could claim funds from the (SURF) Student Undergraduate Research Fund, for which €25,000 is available. PUUR also ran for the last year, coming to an end in December 2016. *(See the Appendix for a detailed overview of faculty and PhD research expenditure. The financial report for student research expenditure was submitted in January 2017 to the UCR management team/executive board).*

In this report, in the publications sections, the names of UCR faculty members are underlined for clarity. Similarly, UCR students who serve as co-authors or co-presenters are indicated with an asterisk*. Please note that since undergraduates publish together with faculty, such undergraduate publications will often be reported in the both the faculty research overview and in the undergraduate research report.

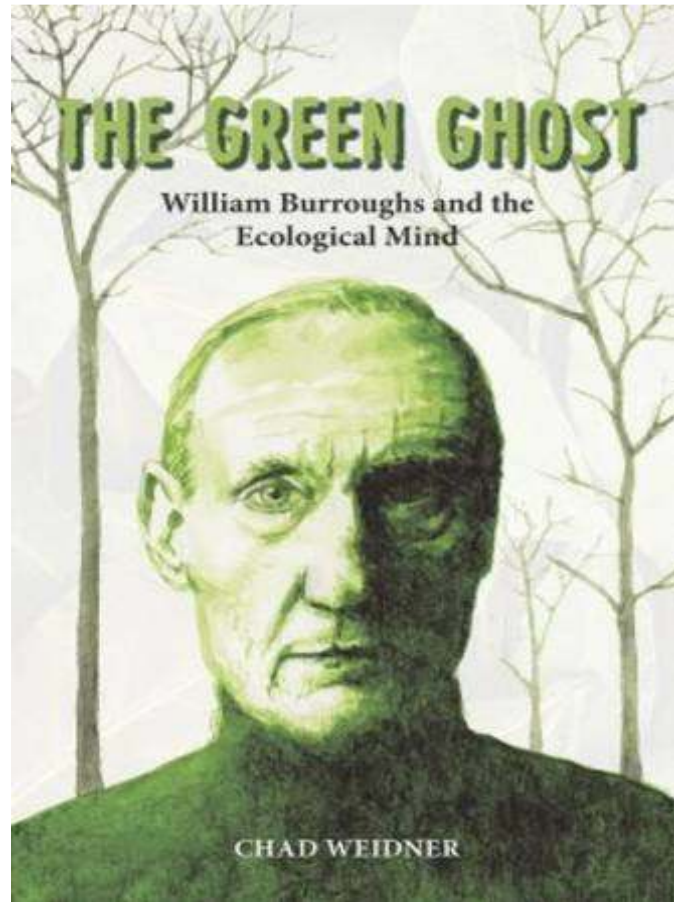
